4. City Manager

6. Review/Action on an Ordinance Imposing a 0.1% Local Sales and Use Tax for the Purpose of Financing Cultural, Recreational and Botanical Organizations or Facilities within the City

Mr. Gordon explained that at the recent General Election the majority of voters voted in favor of the PARC Tax Proposition that was on the ballot. State code requires an ordinance be approved stating that the city will be imposing a 0.1% sales and use tax. The PARC Tax will take effect on April 1, 2018 and remain in effect for 10 years after that date.
