- Discussion Regarding the Community Events and Recreation Center (6:12 p.m.)
 - Jay Taggart, Curtis Miner Architecture, presented updated floor plans and exterior elevations for the events center. The Council discussed the general layout and possible changes to the interior, exterior, and site plan.
 - Mayor Richardson suggested increasing the ceiling height in the basement and adding a ramp for double-tiered cart storage, opening up an additional 300 square feet for bathrooms, classroom space, etc. Jay Taggart stated that he believes the cost of that type of golf cart storage system would cost a lot more than the added benefits of some extra space.
 - C. Kirk stated that he feels that the exterior of the building does not fit into the traditional nature of the community.
 - Jay Taggart asked the Council to find pictures of buildings they like as well as buildings they don't like and email them to him.
