This work session of the City of Cedar Hills, having been properly noticed, was called to order at 6:09 p.m. by Mayor Gygi.

Family Festival

Mayor Gygi has approached two of the LDS church stakes about having them each designate one ward per year for Family Festival planning and staffing. Each ward would contribute 40-50 volunteers. Each ward would have an assignment every 5-7 years. The wards would primarily be responsible for providing volunteers during the events. He is also looking into creating a citizen-driven committee to plan Family Festival events. He would like some additional recommendations from the council on a chair for that committee. The committee is going to come up with the theme, the events and help with sponsorships.

C. Zappala stated that he would hope that the chain of command for the committee is similar to what the council follows. If the committee sees an issue with staff support, they should bring that concern to David Bunker.

David Bunker stated that he is looking forward to the help. The council still needs to feel like it is in control of the festival, particularly with the budget. He also feels like LDS church stake and ward involvement might help with avoiding conflicts between Family Festival dates and ward/stake activities.

C. Martinez stated that the areas where the most volunteers are needed are the race/fun run, parade, carnival, and dinner and a movie.

Amendments to Nuisance Ordinance

David Bunker stated that Code Enforcement Officer, Scott McMahan has written this amendment.

C. Augustus stated that some of the requirements/definitions in the code are intentionally vague to allow staff to make judgment calls. He has heard from some residents that the city is not maintaining its own property free of weeds.
