Golf Course Director Report

Wade Doyle stated that he considers a tournament as having at least 32 players. Under the previous golf course director the maximum tournaments per year was 12 tournaments. The last full season saw 32 tournaments. A tournament day will bring in \$4,000–5,000 in revenue. A regular week day brings in about \$2,800. A full-field tournament day will bring in \$8,000. Most companies book their tournaments just a few months in advance. Sports Radio advertising has been the most effective marketing campaign. Valpak generates about 1/3 of weekday play.
